

The Truth of Christ's Love in One Act

In 75 minutes, with three actors and two chairs, *Viable*'s simple-but-powerful storyline captures an unforgettable moment as an aborted child visits her mother in a dream nearly 30 years later. Attempting to ward off guilt, grieving, and shame and protect her own emotional stability amidst post-abortion trauma, the post-abortive mother has clung to and espoused pro-abortion rhetoric for three decades to justify her choice.

- *Viable* is not about the constitutionality of abortion.


Expressed through the unconditional love of a child, the visitor assures her wounded mother of the love, forgiveness, mercy, and grace of Jesus Christ. Forgiven and restored to her Savior, the mother vows to share both her long-held secret and her newly-found freedom with her living daughter who is considering an abortion. As highly controversial and electrically charged a social issue as abortion is, *Viable* follows a journey of forgiveness, renewal, and hope through the eyes of one woman heavy-laden with despair.

Viable was written by Christian New York Times best-selling author and former Disney writer/producer John Hoover. Dr. Hoover first became involved in the right-to-life movement in the 1980s when he was active in Chuck Swindoll's Evangelical Free Church of Fullerton, California. It has not been the legal questions surrounding abortion that have troubled John through all these years as much as the morality of willingly and intentionally terminating innocent human life.

Viable doesn't ask whether abortion is or is not legal; but whether or not abortion can be morally justified from a Christian world view. Moreover, is it moral to deceive women about what they are doing to their bodies and their babies? With more than fifty million abortions in the United States since *Roe v Wade*, the amount of guilt, shame, and grieving for destroyed lives is unimaginable. Only the love, mercy, and grace of Jesus Christ can begin to lift women who have had abortions out of the condemnation they have felt for years.
