## Questions

1. Do you advocate changing the *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton* decisions and *Casey v. Planned Parenthood*, so that elected legislative bodies (the state legislatures and Congress) may once again protect unborn children by limiting and/or prohibiting abortion?
2. Would you vote against any legislation that would weaken or repeal any existing pro-life law or policy?
3. Would you vote against any proposed Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) if it does not contain an “abortion neutralization” amendment?
4. Would you oppose allowing physicians to prescribe lethal drugs for patients who want to end their life?
5. Would you support legislation that would prohibit governmental agencies from requiring pro-life groups and other non-profit groups to disclose to them the name, address, donation history or other identifiable personal information of their donors?
