What is Camp Joshua?

Arkansas Camp Joshua (ACJ) is a three-day camp designed to train high school students to be effective pro-life leaders. It covers all the basics of pro-life issues in classes and handson workshops. Not only will you leave the weekend ready to spread the pro-life message, you will also have a blast making new friends, visiting the State Capitol, playing interactive games, enjoying good food, and other activities.



Who can attend and how much?

Arkansas Camp Joshua is typically open to teens ages 13-19 with some exceptions. ACJ is not a Bible camp or affiliated with any religious denomination. All teens are welcome.

Arkansas Camp Joshua costs \$100 and includes transportation, meals, lodging, materials, and a T-shirt. Make checks payable to Arkansas Right to Life and mail with signed registration forms to: Arkansas Right to Life, P.O. Box 1697, Little Rock, AR 72203.

Where is ACI held?

ACJ will be held at CrossHeirs Retreat Center in Humphrey (crossheirs.org), which is about an hour and 15 minutes from Little Rock, with the only exception being a trip to the State Capitol on Sunday afternoon.

There is a new provision that provides an above the line deduction in charitable contributions for up to \$300 per taxpayer – or \$600 for a married couple – in annual charitable contributions for the year 2020.

It is available only to people who take the standard deduction and do not itemize their deductions.


