- National Winners win cash awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place.

The National Right to Life Jane B. Thompson Oratory Contest is held each year in conjunction with the National Right to Life Convention. High school juniors and seniors write and present original pro-life speeches. Contests are sponsored by many state right to life groups, and the winners of the state contests compete at the national level.

Deadline to enter Arkansas contest February 15th each year.
