

Almost one year ago, Arkansas dodged a bullet. Pro-abortion extremists tried to put an amendment into our state constitution — and they failed.

But across the country, they've been winning. In just 3 years, **14** states have faced pro-abortion amendments. Their agenda is extreme:

- **X** Even basic sanitation laws for abortion facilities **gone**.
- **X** Taxpayer funding for abortion **forced**.

We've seen it happen in 11 states. Even voters who are politically prochoice don't support abortion until birth with no limits — that's why the extreme pro-amendments are written so vaguely.

Arkansas is the most pro-life state in America, but that doesn't make us safe from an extreme pro-abortion amendment. We are a target. And if we're not prepared, they will win here too.
