

Earlier this year, Congress passed a federal budget that included a one-year **defunding of Planned Parenthood** and the abortion industry behemoth *quickly* filed a lawsuit to stop the defunding from going into effect.

While the court considers the case, the judge ruled that Planned Parenthood will continue receiving federal dollars for non-abortive services while the lawsuit is ongoing. This ruling is not the end of the matter, it's only the beginning of a major court battle.

But here's what's remarkable: even with continued federal funding (for now), Planned Parenthood is struggling. Already this year, dozens of Planned Parenthood facilities have closed their doors. One tracker lists 41 facilities that have shuttered! The abortion giant is finding it harder and harder to keep its

business afloat —even before losing all taxpayer subsidies.

What happens if Planned Parenthood loses in court?

According to Planned Parenthood's own statement: "nearly 200 Planned Parenthood health centers in 24 states across the country are at risk of closure" and further, "more than 90% of those closures would occur in states where abortion is legal."

There are 2 Planned Parenthood facilities in Arkansas and they do NOT perform abortions or receive public funding. But here's what is at stake for the unborn around the country: nearly 200 Planned Parenthoods locations shut down, including almost 180 abortion facilities in states whose laws do little or nothing to protect unborn human life. How incredible would that be?! That's the scale of this court fight.
